Submission to the UN Subcommittee on Prevention of Torture (SPT)

Submitted by: Right to Life (R2L) Human Rights Centre

Regarding: Patterns of Police Torture, Misuse of Detention Laws, and Systemic Judicial Failures in Sri Lanka

1. Executive Summary

This submission by the Right to Life (R2L) Human Rights Centre highlights the persistent patterns of torture and other cruel, inhuman, or degrading treatment or punishment (CIDTP) in Sri Lanka. Despite ratifying OPCAT, systemic police torture remains prevalent, facilitated by the weaponization of detention laws like the Prevention of Terrorism Act (PTA) and Section 54 of the Poisons, Opium, and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance. Furthermore, R2L's recent evidence-based campaigns reveal severe structural judicial failures: the chronic underutilization of the *Convention Against Torture and other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment Act, No. 22 of 1994*, unacceptable court delays, and grossly inadequate victim compensation.

2. Organizational Profile & Capacity Building

R2L is one of Sri Lanka's premier human rights organizations, with 23 years of experience in promoting civil and political rights.

- **Grassroots Reach:** The organization operates a nationwide network of 24 Human Rights First Aid Centres (HRFACs) across 19 districts, serving as the first point of contact for victims.
- **Caseload:** Over the past two years, R2L has documented and responded to over 1,800 human rights violation cases. R2L has filed nearly 70 Fundamental Rights (FR) petitions in the Supreme Court (winning 13, with 27 ongoing).
- **Standardizing Documentation:** To ensure that the evidence gathered at the grassroots level meets strict international and legal thresholds, R2L is currently developing comprehensive **Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)**. These SOPs will guide our network of over 500 Human Rights Defenders (HRDs) in the secure, uniform, and medically accurate documentation of torture cases.

3. Current Patterns and Trends of Torture

Based on R2L's daily field operations and documentation, the following critical trends define the current landscape of state-sponsored violence:



- **Endemic Police Torture for Confessions:** Torture is routinely used as a primary investigative tool by law enforcement to extract confessions, rather than relying on forensic or scientific evidence.
- **Weaponization of the PTA:** The Prevention of Terrorism Act (PTA) continues to be utilized to arbitrarily arrest and detain individuals for extended periods. The prolonged denial of bail creates a dark veil under which CIDTP occurs with impunity.
- **Misuse of Drug Laws (Section 54):** Authorities increasingly exploit Section 54 of the Poisons, Opium and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance. By utilizing these provisions, police bypass standard judicial safeguards, keeping suspects in prolonged remand custody where they are highly vulnerable to severe beatings.

4. Systemic Judicial Failures

R2L has recently conducted a comprehensive review of 100 Supreme Court FR judgments, cases filed under the 1994 Torture Act, and HRCSL complaints. This research, heavily featured in our advocacy campaigns and published across our official website (right2lifelanka.org) and our human rights news portal (Aithiya.lk), highlights three distinct institutional failures:

- **Underutilization of the 1994 Torture Act:** The *Convention Against Torture and other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment Act, No. 22 of 1994* is severely underutilized by the state apparatus. Prosecutions under this Act are exceedingly rare, demonstrating a lack of political and institutional will to hold perpetrators criminally accountable.

R2L requested information from the Attorney General's Department regarding cases filed under this Act. According to the information received, approximately 120 cases have been filed under the Act. Please refer to the two responses received from the Attorney General's Department at different times. There appear to be some discrepancies between the details provided in the two responses. (Annexure 2)

- **Severe Judicial Delays:** Our research exposes extreme delays in case hearings and trials. Victims of torture frequently wait years sometimes over a decade for a resolution, subjecting them to prolonged psychological trauma and financial ruin.
- **Inadequate Compensation:** Even when judgments are won, the compensation awarded to victims is meager and entirely insufficient. It fails to reflect the lifelong physical disabilities, psychological damage, and loss of livelihood caused by state-inflicted violence.



5. Recommendations to the State Party

R2L urges the SPT to recommend the following to the Government of Sri Lanka:

- **Enforce the 1994 Torture Act:** Direct the Attorney General's Department to actively and consistently prosecute perpetrators under the *Convention Against Torture Act, No. 22 of 1994*, rather than pursuing lesser disciplinary charges.
- **Standardize and Elevate Compensation:** Establish clear, standardized judicial guidelines to ensure victims of torture receive substantial, rehabilitative compensation that genuinely reflects their suffering.
- **Fast-Track Torture Cases & Remove Time Limits:** Abolish the restrictive "30-day time limit" for filing Fundamental Rights petitions, and establish dedicated fast-track court procedures to eliminate the severe backlog and delays in torture trials.
- **Repeal or Amend Oppressive Detention Laws:** Immediately reform the PTA and Section 54 of the Drug Ordinance to ensure prompt access to bail, legal representation, and judicial oversight.
- **Mandate Unalterable Surveillance:** Require the installation of unerasable CCTV cameras in all police stations and make the use of body-worn cameras compulsory for arresting officers.
